

**2006 DELTA CENTER RESEARCH UPDATE  
FOR PROFESSIONAL CROP ADVISORS**

The 2006 Delta Center Research Update for Professional crop advisors will be on November 20 and 21 from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM each day. CEU's are pending, but CCA's typically get 16 Continuing Education Units, 4-each for the individual subject matter areas.

Continuing education units are tough to get. Sometimes, the presentations can be boring or unpractical. We try to be different here. Our speakers usually work intimately with crop advisors and producers. We ask them to avoid giving the audience a dry, textbook review. Instead we ask them to stress their latest research results- even if the results are preliminary. Our audience wants to learn what is coming down the pike, not yesterday's news.

The fee is \$15.00 per 4-hour session or \$50.00 to attend all four sessions. Lunch is included. Credit hours are officially pending; however, our speakers are all experienced CCA speakers, so we anticipate full approval.

Not a CCA? That doesn't matter. We want our program to be useful and affordable to anyone involved in professional crop advising- CCA or not. That's why we use the initials PCA instead of CCA.

The event is November 20 and 21. Sessions run 8:00 AM to Noon and 1:00 to 5:00 PM each day. You may attend only the sessions you wish or attend all four. The location is the University of Missouri Delta Center Main office In Portageville, Just South of Town on Highway T Portageville is in Southeast Missouri located at mile marker 32 on Interstate Highway 55.

All crops will be covered; however cotton and rice are emphasized.

Preregistration is requested- Call the Delta Center at 573/379-5431. Failure to preregister is punishable by the withholding of lunch! We cannot accept credit cards for payment, but personal or business checks are fine. We can also bill businesses if needed. We prefer payment the day of our event, as opposed to prepayment.
